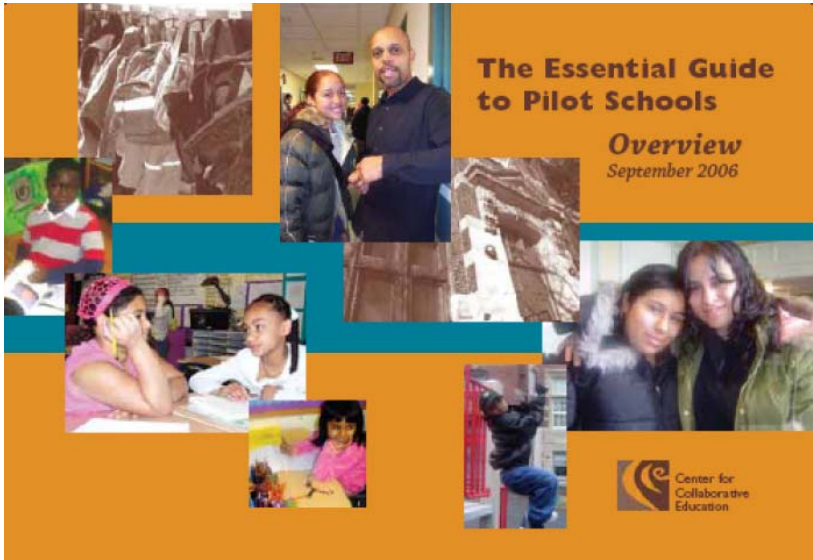




The **Center for Collaborative Education** announces the arrival of **Overview**, the first in *The Essential Guide to Pilot Schools* series!
